## What to do during June

- It has been a fantastic swarm season so far. The nectar flow is still on, so continue to watch your colonies for signs of potential swarming and take preemptive action or watch for swarms to capture.
- Test for varroa. The OSBA's varroa threshold for May-July is 14 mites per 300 bees (approximately 1/2 cup). Looking for options on how to treat? Go to <a href="https://honeybeehealthcoalition.org/varroa">https://honeybeehealthcoalition.org/varroa</a>.
- Monitor for small hive beetles. The first strategy against SHB is a strong colony with no more comb than bees to guard. There are a variety of traps and deterrents on the market that can be used to help them keep the pesky armored insects in check.
- June 17-23 is National Pollinator Week. Celebrate and share the benefits of all pollinators with others.
