### What to do during May

- Swarm season has begun with many captured already. While we don't like our hives to swarm, especially those who have close neighbors, a swarming hive means a healthy robust hive. Swarming will be especially prevalent through nectar flow, so keep an eye out for swarm cells and be ready to implement your plan to prevent swarming or to watch for and capture them. Swarm traps are a great idea!
- If you haven't done so already, test for varroa. The OSBA's varroa threshold for May-July is 14 mites per 300 bees (approximately 1/2 cup). Looking for options on how to treat? Go to <u>https://honeybeehealthcoalition.org/varroa</u>.
- With the mild winter, small hive beetles have a jump start on the 2019 season. Be mindful and ready to employ your choices of trapping and exclusion to protect your bees.
