What to do during April

- Many in our club are getting their first bees this month! Have your plan in place, and a
 backup plan. Try to contact an experienced beekeeper/mentor ahead of time to see if
 they will be available to be present or for a call if needed when you are hiving them.
- Initial inspections on warm (this writer prefers 65 or above), calm days. A few key
 things to observe are the overall health of the bees (any signs of disease/pests?), the
 size of the colony, the brood pattern, and if pollen and nectar are being stored around
 the brood. Don't forget to take notes unless you have a photographic memory!
- While we don't like our hives to swarm, especially those who have close neighbors, a swarming hive means a healthy hive. Swarm season begins in April, so keep an eye out for swarm cells and be ready to implement whatever plan you want to use to prevent swarming or to watch for them. It never hurts to put out swarm traps for that one hive that seems to progress faster than you anticipate!
- Participate in the Bee Informed Partnership survey! Current beekeepers, please take time to participate in the survey which can help guide future management practices of what works and what doesn't. The survey can be found here.
