- Know what you will do to prevent swarming, not applicable for first year beekeepers.
- Choose a mentor and arrange to visit them at their apiary when mutually convenient.
- Referenced from "Beekeeping for dummies by Howland Blackiston:
- Check food reserves.
- Feed the colony if low on capped honey.
- Check for eggs/queen.
- Reverse the hive bodies.
- First comprehensive inspection of the season.
- Season's first check for capped brood and brood pattern.
- Feed a pollen substitute.
