At the October Meeting:

The speaker at our October meeting will be Dr. Hongmei, the Current Director of Research in grooming behavior and landscape ecology of bees, at Central State University.

Dr. Hongmei Li-Byarlay is currently a tenured Associate Professor at Central State University in Wilberforce, Ohio and a Fellow of Royal Entomological Society, President-Elect of the International Branch of the Entomological Society of America (ESA). She obtained her Bachelor degree of Science in Biology and Education at Tianjin Normal University and Master of Science in Zoology at Nan Kai University in China. Her doctoral degree is in Entomology from Purdue University (Indiana) and studied the genetics and physiology of *Drosophila melanogaster*. Then she worked at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (UIUC) and North Carolina State University to study functional genomics and social behavior of honey bees. In 2017, she started her own research lab on bee genetics, genomics, pollinators & ecology. She has received 12 million dollars of external funding from the USDA & NSF for Central State, mentored 40+ undergrad students of HBCU and 1890 land grant, published 49 peer reviewed papers and book chapters including P.N.A.S., Nuclear Acid Research, BMC Genomics etc. She has presented 120 talks for research.

She's on the editorial board of Current Research in Insect Science, Nature Scientific Reports, and Journal of Insect Science. She is the past Chair of the Diversity Inclusion Committee of ESA.

 - Prepare hive for winter
