Our August meeting will be on <u>Sunday, August 11 at 1:30pm, at the church</u>. Our speakers will be Liz and Kevin Jones, owners of *HappBee Acres Bee Supply*. Their talk will be: *Winter is Coming...Are you Ready? Summer Integrated Pest Management (IPM) and other Winter Preparations*. (Yes, winter preparation in our part of the country starts in August!)

Speaker Bio: The Jones's story began with a tree full of bees that fell. Ok, more like years of research culminating in a tree full of bees that fell. After rescuing those bees, a passion was found. They did many cutouts, removals, swarm retrievals, and made lots of splits to grow their apiary. However, work was getting in the way of the passion. Serendipitously, an opportunity arose and they decided to sell their tree care business. They spent the next year growing their apiaries and producing honey for the local community. Purchasing lots of equipment in the spring, they were ready for the upcoming year...2019. Turns out, no one was ready for 2019. With the shutdowns and supply chain issues our local beekeepers were in a bind trying to get equipment. Kevin and Liz offered to sell the extra equipment they had purchased to help everyone out. They ended up going to get more, selling it, and then getting even more! This exposed a need in the community. They decided to change their business name from HappBee Acres Honey to HappBee Acres Bee Supply. In 2020 they officially opened their doors and have been helping the community in ways they never imagined. Equipment, bees and honey aside, they offer classes, education and field days to help local beekeepers be successful. Having already shipped to 47 states, a few countries and vendors at national bee conferences, helping those within driving distance in their priority. Its an honor to help rebuild the community that generations ahead will benefit from.
